THE WINEMAKERS NOTES

The goal for petit rouge was to make a wine that adheres to the same standards and level of care as the rest of the wines at Le Vieux Pin, but at the same time is more accessible upon release.

Made from the fruit of younger vines and vines cropped at an average of 3.5 tons/acre, petit rouge offers a big bang for your buck.

The palate is lively and harmonious. Great balance of fruit, tannin and acid, makes this wine quite versatile. Perfect for any occasion, which was our intention in creating this wine.
